Build and Equip a Mothering Care Unit

Location: Moshi, Tanzania (additional opportunities in Namibia)

Launch: 2010-2011

Frequent breast-feeding is essential for recovery of mom and baby. In many communities, mothers must walk hours every day and night to feed their hospitalized newborns. For weeks on end, others sleep outdoors in hospital courtyards in between their babies' feedings. The Mothering Care Unit serve up to 25 babies at one time in "nurturies" connected to the newborn intensive care unit in the hospital. Mothers provide vital treatment to their critical care babies supervised and supported by nurses. The Mothering Care programs train and empower mothers to provide skin-to-skin therapy, infant massage, optimal bonding and care. This solution improves the mother's health, optimizes the baby's recovery and ongoing development and increases staff resources.
